3. Councils are asked to cover the total cost for their priest to attend and to accompany their priest to Bruno. This is a wonderful way to show support to our priests and to exchange fraternity among us.

Note: Monday evening will be more leisurely as participants will be able to participate in games of their choice, as well as to socialize in Fraternity. Tuesday will be more structured where participants will compete in a variety of games of different levels and interests.
